TAKE NOTICE THAT by direction of the Discipline Committee of the Law Society of British Columbia, a Hearing Panel of the Law Society will, at a date and time to be set, conduct a hearing to inquire into your conduct or competence while a member of the Law Society of British Columbia, in accordance with section 38 of the *Legal Profession Act*. Parts 4 and 5 of the Law Society Rules outline the procedures to be followed at the hearing. Your appearance before the Hearing Panel may be your only opportunity to present evidence, call witnesses or make submissions.

The allegations against you are:

1. Between approximately February 2022 and July 2023, in relation to one or both of your client files # [REDACTED] and # [REDACTED], you permitted the use of your firm's trust account to receive some or all of \$10,050,558.00 or to disburse some or all of \$10,401,808.68, or both, and you failed to do one or more of the following, contrary to one or more of Rule 3-58.1 of the Law Society Rules and rules 2.2-1 and 3.2-7 of the *Code of Professional Conduct for British Columbia* (the "Code"):
 - (a) ensure that the funds were directly related to legal services provided by you or your firm;
 - (b) take reasonable steps to obtain appropriate instructions and pay out the funds as soon as practicable on completion of the services to which the funds related;
 - (c) make reasonable inquiries about the circumstances, including but not limited to:
 - (i) your clients or other persons, or both;
 - (ii) the subject matter and objectives of your retainer; and
 - (iii) the nature and purpose of the transaction(s); and
 - (d) make a record of the results of any inquiries made about the circumstances.

This conduct constitutes professional misconduct, pursuant to s. 38(4) of the *Legal Profession Act*.

If you fail to appear at the hearing, the Hearing Panel may proceed with the hearing in your absence and make any order that it could have made had you been present.
